

Beltane Public Engagement Fellowships Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Deadline: 11am, Monday 17 November 2014

I am not available for interview on one or both of the dates specified. Can you interview me on an alternative date?

Interviews for shortlisted applicants will definitely take place on the 24, 25 or 26 November 2014. If you can only attend interview on one of these dates, please contact us before applying. If you cannot attend for interview on either date then we're sorry, but you cannot apply on this occasion. Our interview panels often contain senior staff whose diaries have very limited availability.

I am a communications officer. Can I apply?

For this opportunity, we can only accept applications from staff on an academic/research contract. This is because we are looking to create ambassadors for culture change within the academic community.

Do you fund Full Economic Costs?

No. Beltane funding can only be used to cover salaries and "on-costs" (e.g. National Insurance). We do not fund estates or indirect costs. If you work at CCACE we will not fund any costs, you will need permission from your line manager to be released for one day per week. CCACE will cover all the additional training and support costs involved in the fellowship programme.

Can I apply if my contract ends less than 6 months after the proposed end date of my Fellowship?

No. We need Fellows to continue to work at their academic institution after their Fellowship ends in order for there to be a good chance of culture change occurring.

Can you give me advice on my application?

Absolutely! We encourage all applicants to contact Beltane before submitting their application. If you work at CCACE Robin Morton (robin.morton@ed.ac.uk) can also help with your application.
